What will we be learning next week.

Nursery

- Literacy:** We will be learning to be animal experts and recalling facts learnt about farm animals.
Maths: We will be learning to combined two groups of animals and then counting to find the total
Other areas: We will be talking about our own families and talking about how all families are different.
We will learn the 'E' sound in phonics.

Reception: P.E day is Monday

- English:** We will be looking at the story of The Little Red Hen
Maths: We will be learning about money and looking at coins
Other: We will also be learning that a plant/flower needs soil, water and sunlight in order to grow

Year 1: P.E days are Tuesday and Friday

- English:** We are innovating and writing our own poems based on 'In My Magic Garden'
Maths: We are recapping missing number problems
Science: We are going on a trip to Cassiobury park on Wednesday to look at signs of Spring
