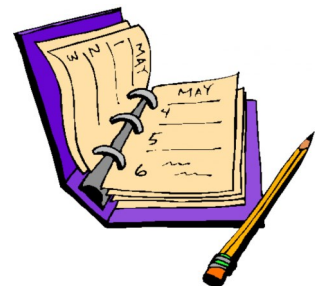

What will we be learning next term

Nursery

- Literacy:** We will be reading Snail Mail by Sharon King-Chai, Billy's Beetle by Nick Inkpen and learning some rhymes and poems.
- Maths:** We will be comparing lengths, talking about simple routes and locations and solving some simple problems.
- Other:** We will enjoy learning about an artist during arts week, sports day and a walk to post a letter.

Reception: P.E day is Friday

- Maths:** We will be learning to count backwards from a given number.
- Literacy :** We will be learning to write sentences on what we did over half term.
- Other:** We will be looking at how we change over time (Please bring in a named baby picture of your child).

Year 1: P.E days are Monday and Tuesday

- Maths:** We will be recapping addition and subtraction.
- English:** We will be looking at and learning jungle poetry.
