# What will we be learning next week.

## Nursery

- Literacy:** We are listening to the traditional story, Goldilocks and the Three Bears.  
**Maths:** We will be learning about size and using word Big, Medium and Small through stories, actions and songs.  
**Other:** We will be making a Bear puppet to learn about using tape and glue to join pieces together.

## Reception: PE Kit to be in school at all times

- Maths:** We will be subitising numbers to 10.  
**Literacy:** We will be learning to use initial sounds to label some characters from the story.  
**Other:** We will be learning about our families.

## Year 1: PE Kit to be in school at all times

- English:** We will be innovating the story based on 'My Granny went to Market'.  
**Maths:** We will be learning different methods of addition and subtraction.  
**Art:** We will be learning how to mix different colours using paint.

## Year 2: PE Kit to be in school at all times

- English:** We will be finishing our retelling of George and the Dragon and adding our own endings. We will also be learning to use verbs in the correct tense.  
**Maths:** We will be learning about related addition and subtraction facts and practising adding multiples of 10 to 1 and 2 digit numbers.  
**History:** We will be continuing to learn about the Battle of Hastings and the Bayeux Tapestry.  
**Geography:** We will be continuing to learn about the countries which are in the United Kingdom.
